# **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1.0 RULES

1.1 Racing will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the Prescriptions of the RYA, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions issued for this event and the Class Rules. In the event of a conflict, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence.

# 2.0 RYA Racing Charter

2,1 Competitors should note that Alton Water Sports Centre, as the organising authority, implements the RYA Racing Charter and that all competitors are required to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found in the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2017- 2020) or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter

#### 3.0 Advertising

3.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

#### 4.0 ELIGIBILITY

4.1 The event is open to all paid up members of the UK Finn Class Association.

# 5.0 ENTRY FEE

5.1 The entry fee for the event is £30 and will be collected by the BFA on Saturday morning. Entries may be completed at registration on Saturday March 17<sup>th</sup>.

#### 6.0 REGISTRATION OF COMPETITORS

6.1 The Race Office will be open for competitor registration from 0900 on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> March.

## 7.0 PROGRAMME AND SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 7.1 There will be a maximum of 8 races and a maximum of 1 discard will be allowed if 5 or more races are sailed.
- 7.2 The first race will not start before 1230 on Saturday. The last race will not start after 15.00 on Sunday.
- 7.3 The target duration of each race will be 35 minutes.

#### 8.0 BRIEFING

8.1 There will be a competitor briefing at 11.30 on Saturday and 09.30 on Sunday.

#### 9.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 The sailing instructions will not be issued at registration but will be available on the BFA and AWSC websites.

#### 10.0 COURSES AND RACING AREA

- 10.1 Racing will take place on Alton Water Reservoir within the limits prescribed in the sailing instructions.
- 10.2 Courses will be laid using fixed and portable marks as deemed appropriate by the OOD.
- 10.3 Starting and finishing will be from a committee boat.

#### 11.0 RULES DISPUTES, PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

11.1 The Exoneration Penalty (and Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration) of the RYA Rules Dispute Procedures will be available.

#### 12.0 SCORING

- 12.1 One race will be sufficient to constitute a series.
- 12.2 The low points system of scoring will be applied.
- 12.3 The number of races to be discarded will be as follows:
  - 5 or more races sailed 1 discard
  - Less than 5 races sailed no discard.

#### 13.0 BERTHING

- 13.1 There is limited storage of competitors' boats available, free of charge, for the duration of the event.
- 13.2 Competitors wishing to leave their craft at the centre on the night immediately preceding or following the event may do so, provided arrangements are made with AWSC prior to the event, taking account of centre closing times.

#### 14.0 PRIZES

- 14.1 Prizes will be awarded to at least the first five boats in the Finn fleet and to the first Finn classic boat. Other prizes may also be awarded.
- 14.2 The prize giving will take place as soon as practicable after the last race.

#### 15.0 RISK STATEMENT

- Rule 4 of the RRS states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue to race is hers alone" and that sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
  - a. They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
  - b. They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
  - c. They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
  - d. Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
  - e. The provision of a race management team, patrol boats if any and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
  - f. The provision of patrol boat cover if any is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can practically be provided in the circumstances;
  - g. Personal buoyancy shall be worn by all competitors whilst afloat;
  - h. Their boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular, to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000.

## 16.0 SOCIAL

- 16.1 It is planned that breakfast will be available in the Café at Alton Water Sports Centre from 08:00 both Saturday and Sunday mornings, but please check this in advance with the Centre.
- 16.2 The Café will also be serving hot food and drinks throughout Saturday and Sunday.

#### 17.0 RIGHTS TO NAMES AND LIKENESSES

17.1 Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority, without payment, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures, taped, or filmed television of or relating to the event.

#### 18.0 RADIO COMMUNICATION

18.1 A boat shall neither make nor receive radio communications while racing. This restriction includes the use of mobile telephones.

#### 19.0 INSURANCE

19.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 for any one incident and shall sign a declaration to that effect before going afloat.
